Silver Expedition

There are seven training sessions (duration of 2 hours per session) at the centre that will cover basic canoe/kayak skills, camp craft, safety, first-aid and personal equipment. After this initial training phase all participants will be ready to undertake an expedition.

The training expedition is a 3 day, 2 night practice expedition that is supervised and allows participants to prepare themselves for their assessment.

The assessment expedition is a 3 day, 2 night expedition that is supervised from a remote location.

The award is nationally recognised and is a known way to develop young people's independence and personal capabilities.

We can also provide opportunities to complete the Volunteering, Physical and Skills sections of each award.

The price is an all inclusive package of £600 per person, this covers transport, equipment, accommodation, staffing and accreditation.

Participants are required to supply their own food and personal clothing for the training and assessment expeditions.

This price is based on a minimum group of 8.
